This is an open call for artists of Washtenaw County to join all the members of the Ann Arbor Women Artists in an Online Exhibit. It is non-juried and there will be no financial or honorary awards designated. The Exhibit will take place on the Ann Arbor Women Artists website.

Guidelines For Entry:

- A. Submissions are open to all AAWA members no matter where they live and to all Washtenaw County Artists 18 years and older.
- B. Submissions must be related to the artist's interpretation of the theme of the show: Racial Dialogues Through Art: Reflections on the issues of our time.
- C. All submission fees are being waived for this exhibit. Entry is free.
- D. This is a 2D/3D exhibit. Up to two works can be submitted by each artist.
- E. Submissions of 3D works are accepted and encouraged. Please note that we will need two photos for each 3D piece. One of the front and one of the back.
- F. All artwork must be original.

- G. Image files must be 1000 pixels on the longest side with a resolution of 72ppi in JPEG/JPG or PNG format.
- H. Image file names: lastname-firstname-title-medium-artsizesaleprice
 - ~ Example 2D: doe-jane-in-the-clouds-pastel-12x9-250
 - ~ Example 3D: doe-john-forever-yours-bronze-wood-10x5x6-400
 - ~ Art size for 2D: Height x Width
 - ~ Art size for 3D: Height x Width x Depth
 - ~ These measurement numbers should all be inches
- I. 2D measurements for unframed pieces. This is for the purpose of information for potential buyers.
- J. Artists will be filling out registration forms for each image. A brief description/explanation can be provided about the artwork if the artist so chooses.
- K. AAWA reserves the right to refuse any work that is not appropriate for this exhibit.
- L. From Sept 15 to Oct 9, 2020, the submission page will be open for image registration at <https://annarborwomenartists.org/racial-dialogues>
